Dr. Repke's clinical interests include high-risk pregnancy, pre-eclampsia and hypertension, and medical complications of pregnancy. Dr. Repke is a member of Alpha Omega Alpha (AOA), and is a Fellow of the American Gynecological and Obstetrical Society (AGOS), the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) and is a full member of the Society for Maternal-Fetal Medicine (SMFM) and The Society for Gynecologic Investigation (SGI). Dr. Repke is also Past President of The North American Society for the Study of Hypertension in Pregnancy. Dr. Repke serves as an Examiner for The American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Inc. in both General Obstetrics and Gynecology and in Maternal-Fetal Medicine. He is the author of over 250 publications, has presented numerous abstracts at national and international scientific meetings and has edited a textbook of Obstetrics.
