The Department of Neurosurgery at Penn State Milton S. Hershey Medical Center is seeking a neurosurgeon for a full-time physician-scientist position. The Department of Neurosurgery, a component of the Clinical Neuroscience Institute, is a robust academic neurosurgical practice with 23 full time clinical and research faculty members and numerous multi-disciplinary programs. Excellent opportunities for basic, translational and clinical research exist within the Department of Neurosurgery, the Clinical Neuroscience Institute, the Center for Neural Engineering and Penn State University. This appointment will be at the Assistant or Associate Professor level and will entail at least a 60% research commitment. Protected research time, basic or clinical laboratory space and start-up funds are part of the recruitment package. Neurosurgeons within 6 years of finishing their training, who have a commitment to a career in academic neurosurgery that includes neurosurgical research are encouraged to apply. Qualified candidates must have completed an approved residency training program. Additional fellowship training in any neurosurgical subspecialty is preferred but not required.
