iPhone Exchange ActiveSync Setup

With Exchange ActiveSync, you can wirelessly push company email, calendar, events, and contacts from Microsoft Exchange Server your iPhone. To set up your iPhone to access your Exchange server, follow the steps below:



- On the Home screen, tap **Settings**
- Tap **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**.
- Tap **Add Mail Account**
- Tap **Microsoft Exchange**



- Enter your **Email, Domain** (hershey.med), **Username** (ePass id), **Password** (ePass password), and a **Description**
- The Domain **MUST** be **hershey.med**. Use **SSL ON**
- When setup is complete your iPhone will display a list of data types to sync with Exchange. Choose from the list and tap **Done** to initiate the first sync
