Adults and children with Cystic Fibrosis in critical medical need are being offered an opportunity to receive open label VX-770. This is an Expanded Access Program which will give patients that qualify the opportunity to orally administer VX-770 until it gains approval by the FDA.

WHO MAY VOLUNTEER?

Cystic Fibrosis patients greater than 6 years old presently with the G551D-CFTR mutation. Must be able to perform pulmonary function testing, administer medicine, and must be able to follow the instruction of the study doctor.
