



MONITORING CRITERIA FOR PUVA PATIENTS

- 1. Baseline lab tests done prior to first PUVA treatment: CBC, BUN, creatinine, liver function tests, urinalysis, ANA.
- 2. Baseline eye exam within 2 months of starting PUVA.
- 3. Follow-up eye exams annually, ± 2 months.
- 4. Follow-up dermatology clinic appointment every 4 months \pm 2 months while receiving PUVA therapy.
- 5. If a patient stops, then restarts PUVA therapy, the baseline labs and baseline eye exam need not be repeated.
- 6. All eye exams should be documented in the chart either by copy of eye exam or formal letter from examining ophthalmologist.
