

Dear Class of 2015 Medical Student,

Congratulations on your acceptance to the Penn State University College of Medicine! Please review this important information on the website listed below. Complete these requirements as soon as possible. Your quick response enables our staff to review your information and point out deficiencies, as you will not be able to begin classes without completion of all requirements.

These forms must be printed, completed and return to the Student Health Department.

Go to www.pennstatehershey.org/web/studenthealth/home and print the forms as instructed below and returned to the Student Health office by June 1st.

1. **Print immunization titer guidelines for your medical provider.**
2. Physical exam form completed and signed by your physician within the past 12 months.
3. Immunization Record and titers **completed and signed** by physician. (Make sure to include lab copies of titers drawn.) Information must be recorded on Penn State forms; "See attached" for immunization records will not be accepted.
4. Health History form **completed by student**.
5. Pre-registration form completed with your current Insurance card copied and attached. (You will learn more about the insurances available to you as a medical student at orientation.)

Fees will be incurred for not completing these requirements before June 1st. The fees are as follows:

After June 1st \$50.00;
After June 15th \$100.00;
After July 11th \$150.00.

Students accepted after May 1st will have **4 weeks from their acceptance date** to complete their requirements before incurring the \$50.00 fee.

6 weeks the fee increases to \$100.00

8 weeks to \$150.00.

You will also find additional information for **housing** and a waiver for **health insurance**. Please note these forms **are mailed to separate addresses** and there is no late fee.

Thank you for your cooperation and prompt attention to these important documents and deadlines as it is our hope that you do not incur any late fees. Please mail all health forms to:
