## Have HAE?

Penn State Milton S. Hershey Medical Center researchers are trying to determine if a new investigational drug can improve and/or control a hereditary angioedema attack (HAE). Volunteers who are at least 13 years old with a diagnosis of HAE are needed to participate.

Participation requires notifying the study coordinator of an HAE attack and visiting the clinic within five hours of the onset of the attack to receive study drug or placebo treatment.
