

## Section Chief, Benign Hematology

The Penn State Milton S. Hershey Medical Center, Division of Hematology/Oncology and Penn State Hershey Cancer Institute, seek to appoint an experienced Hematologist with an established track record of research in hemostasis, thrombosis, endothelial cell biology, (and/or other areas of hematology). The clinician scientist will assume the leadership position of the Benign Hematology Section in the Division of Hematology/Medical Oncology as either Associate Professor or Professor. The Section Chief will also serve as the Medical Director of the Special Hematology and Hemostasis Laboratories, with an appropriate departmental joint appointment. This is a tenure track, clinician-scientist position supported by an endowed professorship in Hematology. Clinical responsibilities are estimated to be 50% effort, with the remaining 50% balanced between research, teaching and administrative duties. (Administrative responsibilities will be strictly limited and handled mostly at the Hematology/Oncology Division level.)

The appointed Section Chief/Hematologist will join the existing federally and state funded Hemophilia & Thrombosis Center in the region to provide comprehensive care, clinical research and education in disorders of hemostasis and thrombosis. The successful candidate is expected to develop a multi-disciplinary research program in the area of hemostasis, thrombosis or endothelial cell biology. There will be multiple opportunities for collaboration within the College of Medicine, other University Colleges at the Penn State University Park campus, and the Hershey Center for Applied Research located adjacent to the Medical Center. The Section Chief/Hematologist will be an integral part of the Hematology Fellowship program as well as the Hematology/Oncology Fellowship program.

The position is available immediately, and will remain open until filled. Salary level, total compensation, and start-up package will be highly competitive

The position is located within the University's academic medical center with a major 551-bed teaching/research hospital providing high-level, patient-focused medical care via an integrated service delivery model. The Penn State Hershey campus also includes the College of Medicine, Children's Hospital, the Cancer Center, a CTSA, an Institute for Personalized Medicine, and other specialty facilities.

Located in a rural setting, this position offers the advantages of living in a low-population density community but with close proximity to several major metropolitan centers.
