2 If your research involves materials from more than one category, you should submit your approval forms for use of biohazards, radioisotopes or hazardous chemicals prior to your submission to the IRB or IACUC.

3 Infectious agents, select agents and toxins, unfixed human or animal cells or tissues.

4 Biosafety requirements apply to all human tissues, in addition to requirements mandated by human subjects protection and processes for obtaining samples. For more details, visit PennStateHershey.org/web/irb.

5 Also need an Authorization to Procure and Use Radioactive Material form.

* All approvals are contingent on completion of the appropriate safety training. Also be sure to follow your department's and institute's policy for pre-submission approval or scientific review.
