## 2014 Woodward Education Grants

The Woodward Endowment Steering Committee announces that applications are now being accepted for the 2014 Woodward Endowment for Medical Sciences Education grant awards. The deadline for submitting applications is **Tuesday January 7<sup>th</sup>, at 5:00pm EST.** The funding period will run from March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 through February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

We are accepting applications for:

- **Innovation in Education Projects and Research Awards**
  - **Level I Awards** provide \$500-\$3,000 of support for innovative pilot projects in education research or one-time investments to support innovative projects to improve a specific aspect of our education resources.
  - **Level II Awards** provide \$3,000-\$25,000 of support for innovative educational research or projects that provide an innovative improvement in curriculum supported by quantitative outcomes assessment.
  
- **Woodward Education Scholar Awards**
  - **Level I Awards** provide reimbursements of up to \$2,000 to support travel costs and registration fees for a single conference or training opportunity in health sciences education or education research. A summary report and a presentation disseminating the educational benefits of the travel are required.
  - **Level II Awards** confer the title “Woodward Education Scholar” and provide up to \$10,000 to support costs associated with travel to institutions for formal training in health sciences education or education research, followed by a formal scholarly project at HMC to implement and disseminate the acquired knowledge and skills.

These grant programs are available on a competitive basis to individuals involved in the educational mission of the PSU College of Medicine and Milton S. Hershey Medical Center. Please refer to the website for applications and additional information and instructions at:
