


Call for: POSTER ABSTRACTS

The planning committee for the 21st Annual Neuroscience Conference is very excited to offer another two-day conference and invites you to submit an abstract to be considered for a poster presentation. Topics for submission should be presented as clinical research or clinical practice neuroscience topics in the appropriate format. You may consider a case study review as well.

The top ten poster abstracts will be invited to display at the conference.

Everyone will be notified by email by February 28, 2014. The author(s) or their representative(s) will be expected to display a poster and be available to the participants during the break times. Authors of accepted poster abstracts will receive a single \$50.00 discount on the conference registration (only one discount per poster and per person). Prizes will be awarded by the Susquehanna Valley of AANN.

The signing author certifies that any work with human or animal subjects related in this abstract complies with the guiding principles for experimental procedures as set forth in the Declaration of Helsinki, in the American Physiological Society's "Guiding Principles in the Care and Use of Animals," and in the NIH "Guide for Grants and Contracts." Appendix 1, Vol. 7, No. 17 (November 1978).

This poster abstract may have been presented at a previous national meeting.

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Submission Guidelines

Deadline: February 17, 2014

- Abstracts must be submitted in Word format
- Allow 1-inch margins on all sides
- Use 12 pt font
- Accepted abstracts will be reproduced as submitted in conference handout packets

Include the following information with each submitted abstract

- Title of poster abstract
- Name and credentials of author(s)
- Name of presenter (if different from above)
- Contact Information of submitting author(s)
 - Phone number
 - Fax number
 - Complete mailing address
 - Email address
- CV of submitting author or presenter
- Abstracts should begin with abstract title and author name(s), followed by the narrative

Additional Information

- Submissions will be judged on the merits of the abstract
- Poster presenters must register for the meeting
- Poster boards will be provided
