This clerkship site is located at The Reading Hospital Family Health Care Center, which is also the site of the Family Medicine Residency Program. The practice is varied with respect to patient demographics and clinical problems. It includes a significant pediatric and geriatric population as well as obstetrical patients. Experiences here will help to develop history and physical examination skills, diagnostic expertise and practice management skills. The student is exposed to a wide variety of common office-based medical conditions. Patient contacts are structured so that the student will have some autonomy in diagnosing and managing these conditions while working under direct attending supervision. Experience is obtained in dermatology, gastroenterology and university student health clinics. Students are exposed to common minor office procedures including colposcopy, IUD insertion, dermatologic procedures, and joint injection. The student will participate in procedure workshops, and home visits. One overnight session of call per rotation is expected. Some exposure to inpatient medicine can be arranged.
