York Hospital (part of Wellspan Health) is the region's leader in advanced specialty care. What began in 1880 has become a 558-bed community hospital that employs more than 3,400 people and serves a population of 520, 000 in south central Pennsylvania. Students see patients at the Thomas Hart Family Practice Center, which is part of the family medicine residency program founded in 1968. The family practice center is connected to the hospital and has 24 exam rooms, two procedure rooms, a lab, and a conference room, as well as offices for the faculty and residents. The average number of outpatient visits per year is approximately 23,000. These visits include well-child care, maternity care, adult care, and numerous outpatient procedures. The family practice center has been using an electronic health record since September 2006. Students will spend most of their time at the Thomas Hart Family Practice Center, but will also spend two half-days per week at a private family medicine office in the community. There is a half-day block session of education in which all students participate, as well as weekly session sin the York Hospital Simulation Center. Students are supervised by Stacey Robert, M.D. and her administrative assistant who coordinates the student rotations is Christie Colon.
